The Master of Science Program in Epidemiology (International Program) emphasizes harmony between theory and practice in both academic teaching and research, enabling students to have a strong foundation in research and critical thinking in public health and epidemiology. Students take coursework together with doctoral students during their first year and conduct master-level thesis research in the second year. This process connects the science of the profession with other disciplines, enabling students to fully understand the sciences of global health in terms of magnitude and determinants of health problems and the solution to improve population health for good health and well-being. The Program lays a foundation for those with an undergraduate background in health science or work experience in health care and service to enter the world of research and to become fully capable of conducting preliminary studies. Graduates will be able to use their training to solve population health issues and become inspired to undertake further studies and research in the future. Graduates also will have gained experience in research methodology and earned publications to enable successful pursuit of higher studies in related programs at leading universities. Our Program's alumni have found employment in the public sector, universities, and the private sector as research assistants, researchers, statisticians, data managers, data analysts, data guality controllers, and clinical research coordinators.
