The additional eligibility criteria include: having at least 1 year of research experience related to agriculture or natural resources with a certificate from the supervisor or have academic works that have been published. Applicants must have English proficiency test results according to the criteria set by the graduate school or at the discretion of the program executive committee.</p> <p>Plan 2.1: Coursework 12 credits and Dissertation 36 credits</p> <p>Plan 2.1 is for applicants who have already completed a master’s degree in agriculture or related fields. The additional eligibility criteria include: having research experience related to agriculture or natural resources and having English proficiency test results according to the criteria set by the Graduate School or at the discretion of the Program Executive Committee.</p>
