The applicant should have a solid background in research methodology. It is also preferred that he applicants have publications or other forms of academic work. The final decision is subject to the discretion of the selection committee.</p> <p>2) The applicant is required to show proficiency in English and test scores of no more than two years old should be submitted along with other application materials.
