<p>Doctor of Philosophy Program Islamic Studies, Plan 1.1 and Plan 1.2, which focus on students to undertake advanced research for thesis only. There are 48 thesis credits throughout the program for graduates with a master's degree and for graduates (First class honors or a specific GPA of not less than 3.5) with a bachelor's degree of 72 credits, the research results must be published in a standard academic journal. If the student does not have enough knowledge in Islamic Studies and Muslim Studies, he/she must register for certain courses as prescribed by the advisor or program administrator without credit counting.</p>
