Qualification of applicants	<p>For Plan 1.1, candidates must hold a Master's degree in educational administration with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.50 and meet the English proficiency requirements as specified in the Graduate School's announcement for doctoral level study.</p> <p>Under Plan 2.1, candidates should have completed a Master's Degree in educational administration or other related fields, achieving a cumulative GPA of at least 3.50.</p> <p>Additionally, they must fulfill the English language proficiency standards outlined in the graduate college's announcement for doctoral level applicants.</p> <p>or</p> <p>There is an additional prerequisite: candidates must possess a Master's degree from a higher education institution accredited by the University Council. Furthermore, applicants are required to have a minimum of five years of work experience in an educational setting, wherein they held responsibilities related to education.</p> <p>*Applicants who have successfully met the standards or equivalent for English proficiency will be exempted from the requirement to study.</p>
