<p>Doctor of Philosophy Program in Oral Health Sciences is offered by Faculty of Dentistry, Prince of Songkla University (PSU). The program has provided both thesis study plan and thesis with coursework plan. Moreover, this program is the first in Thailand which launched a major in Combined Research and Clinical Training (CRCT). It is a combination of clinical specialty training and research experience. The courses with learning and teaching activities are performed in English for international candidates.</p>

Those who completed this program will receive the Ph.D. degree and certificate certified that they passed the dental training in order to request for dentist licensure issued by the Royal College of Dental Surgeons of Thailand.</p> <p>Moreover, this program allows for only students who completed the Bachelor degree in Doctor of Dental Surgery program.</p>
